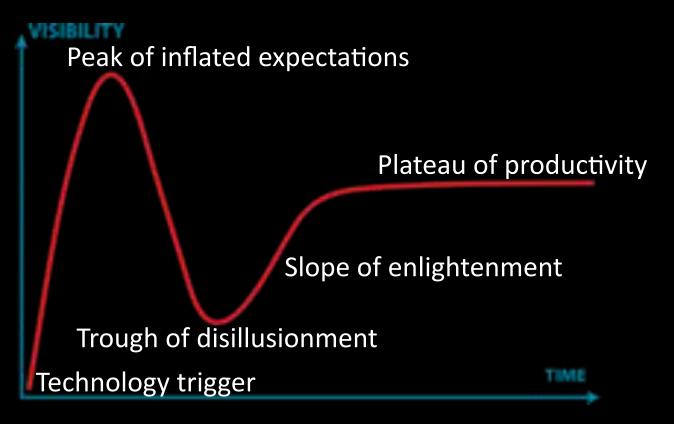
How does 3D work?

- Disparity stimulates stereopsis
- Stereopsis signals only relative depth

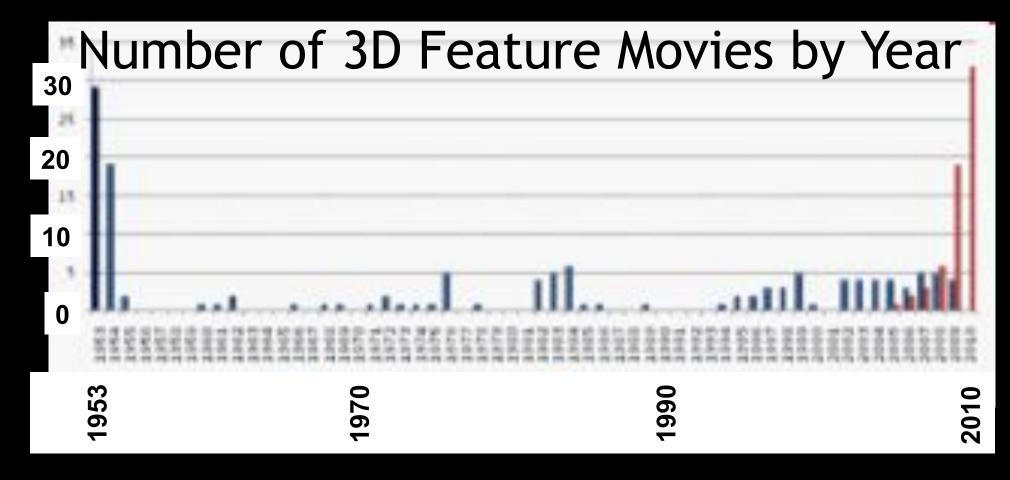

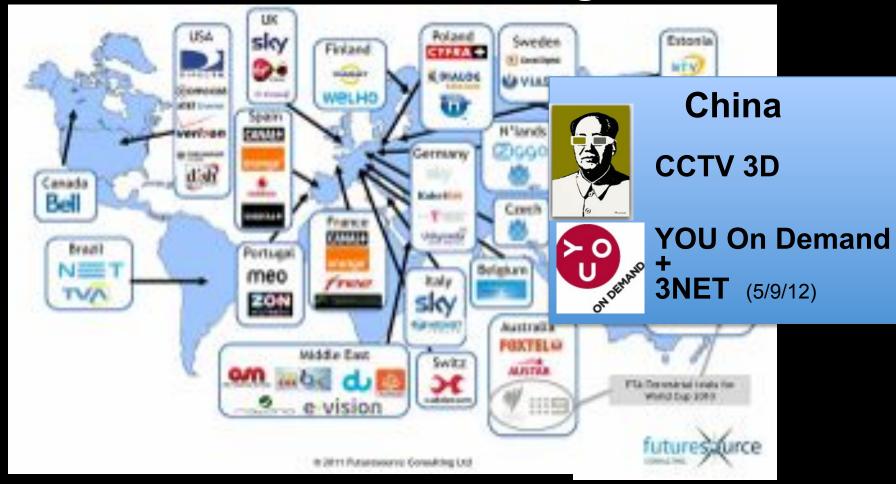

60 3D Broadcasters as of August 2011

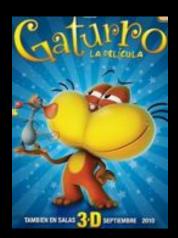

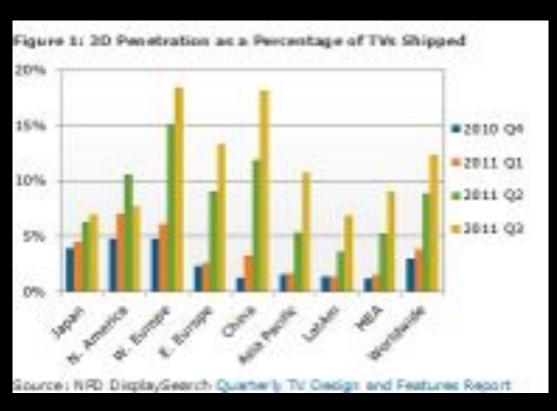

It is therefore more a viewers ease of viewing that the TV set from Sony will be catering for, rather than the director's choice of focus. ...

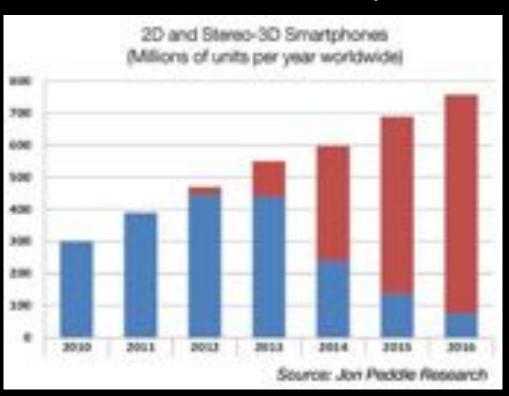

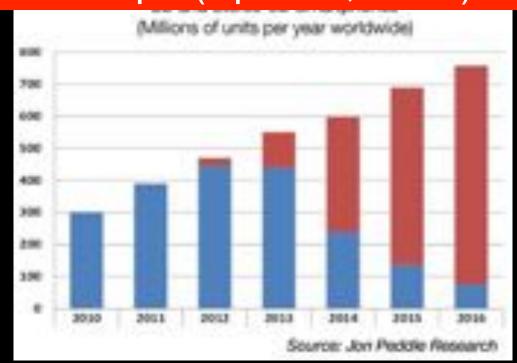

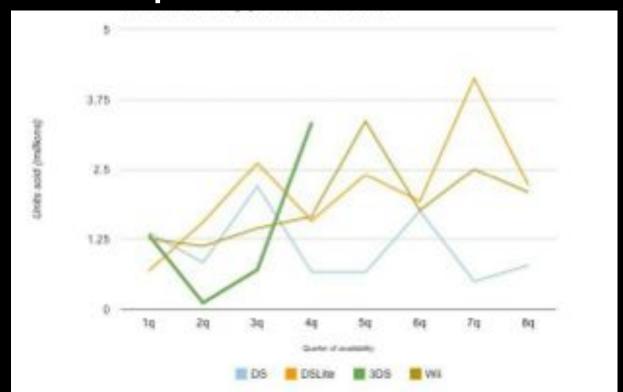

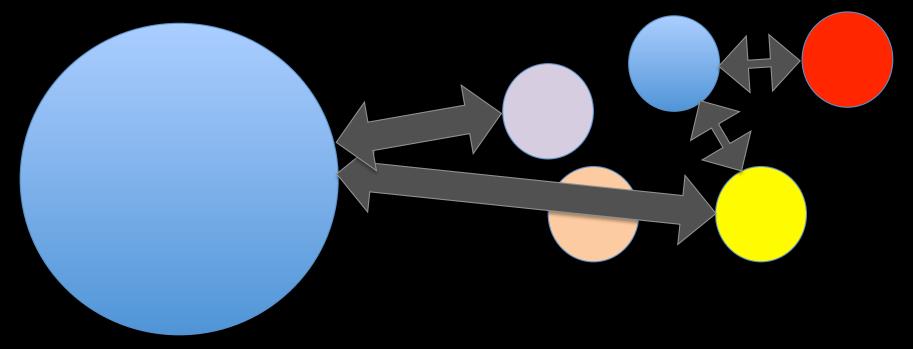

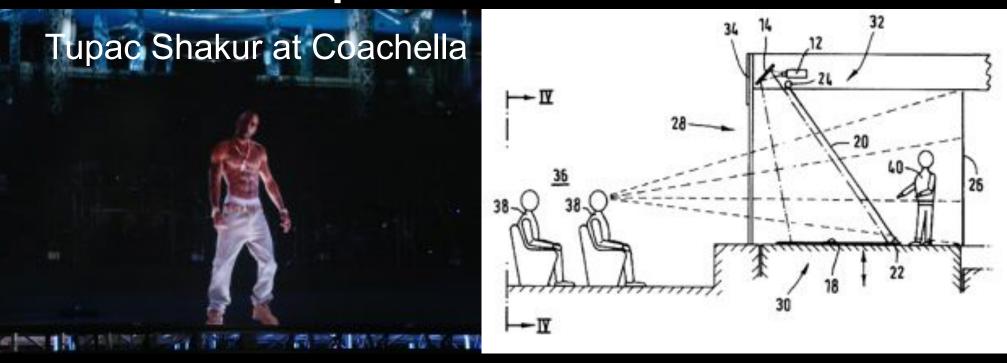

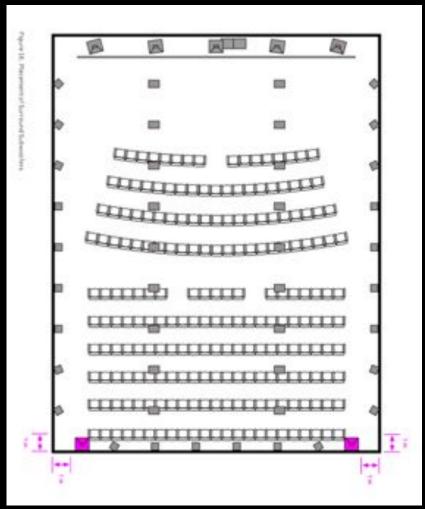

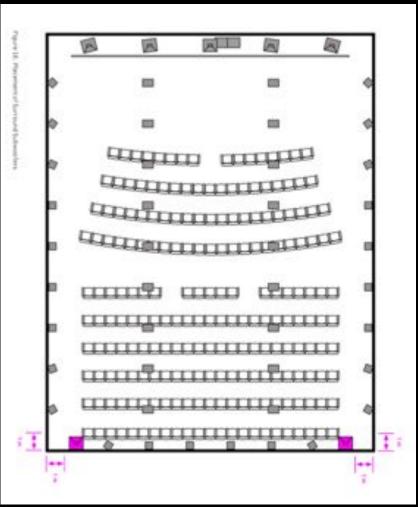

3D Audio Hemisphere of Sound

Recognizes the subconscious's ability to determine the origin of a sound without necessarily seeing the physical occurrence

Dolby 3 layer approach

- lower horizontal layer
- height layer
- directly overhead

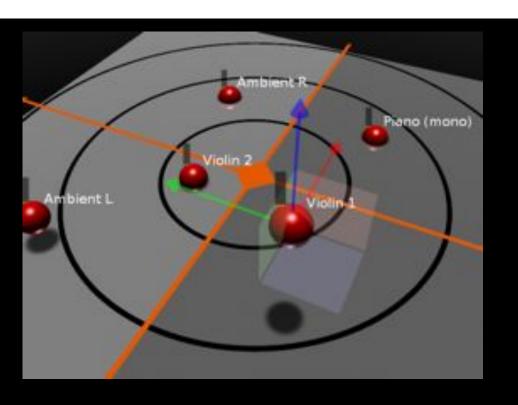


Dolby Atmos 10-15 theatres worldwide for Pixar's Brave in June, 2012

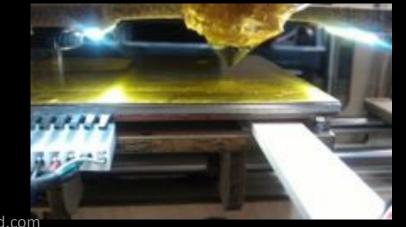

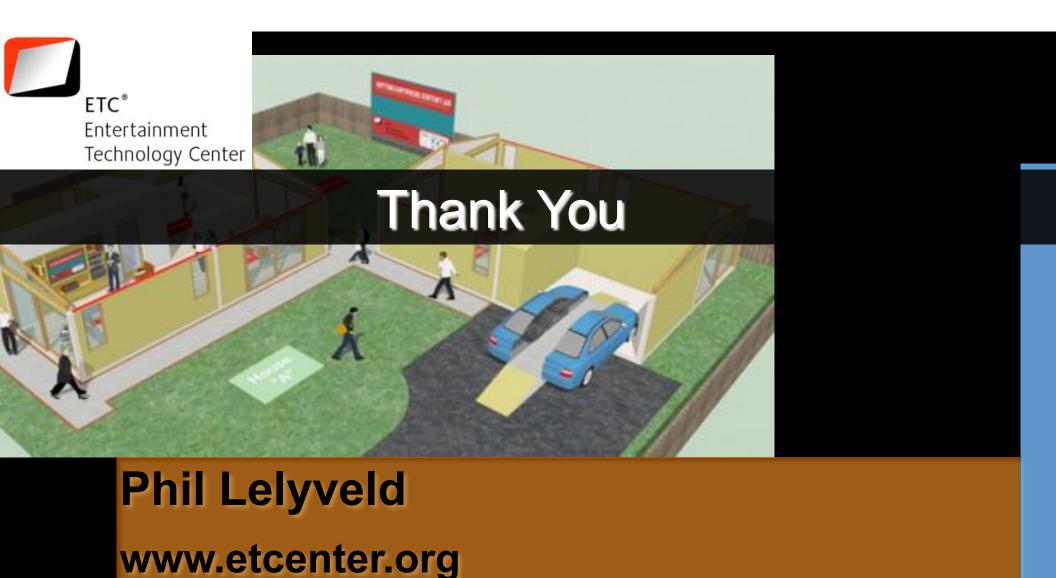
